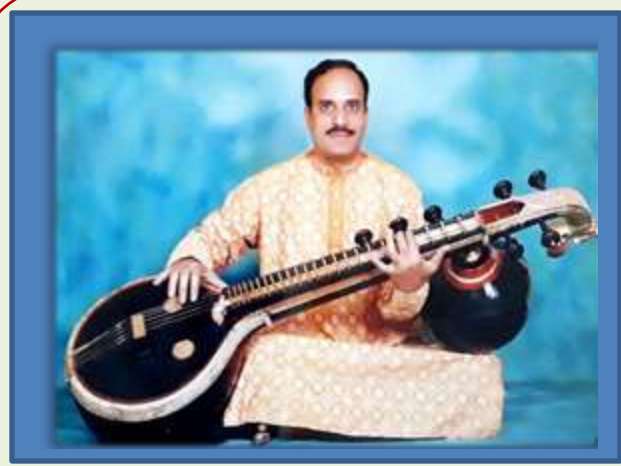

Srinivas Meduri comes from a family with a long tradition in Carnatic classical music. His parents, late Sri. Narasimha Rao & Smt. Prasunamba and his elder sister, Smt. Kattamuri Subbalakshmi, were his teachers. He is one of the youngest "A" Grade veena artists of All India Radio. He has received the first prize for three consecutive years in the senior section of classical music category of Veena, in the All India Competitions. He has performed all over India, for many major Sabhaas.

Srinivas has performed in various programs including the National Program of Music for Doordarshan, TTD's Naada Neerajanam, & Annual Festival of Andhra Music Academy.

He will be accompanied on Mridangam by Nirmal Narayan, disciple of Dr. P.V. Ananthakrishnan.

Nirmal Narayan received his training from Dr. P.V. Ananthakrishnan, a mridangam disciple of the legendary Ramanathapuram C.S. Murugabhoopathy. Nirmal has participated in several local festivals and aradhanas on the morsing. Nirmal is also the disciple of mridangam maestro Sangeetha Kalanidhi Umayalpuram K. Sivaraman. As a mridangam artist, he has been performing for several years, accompanying many stalwarts in the Carnatic music field. Nirmal holds a degree in economics from the University of California at Berkeley. He is also a teacher and performer.
