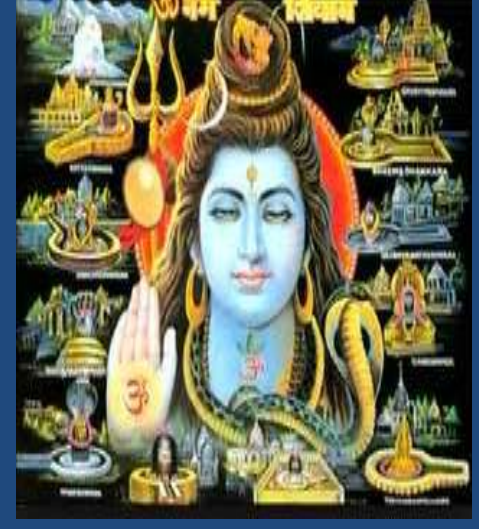

Significance of Jyotirlinga

According to the Linga purana, once Lord Siva asked the Lords Brahma and Vishnu to find the extent of His form, which they were unable to find. Subsequently Lord Siva took the form of an endless Jyothi (pillar of fire). Jyoti means glow and lingam the 'mark or sign' of Siva. Jyotirlinga means "The glowing sign of The Almighty". There are 12 Jyotirlingas where Lord Siva appeared in the form of light (Jyoti) lingam.

Karthika Māsa marks the victory of Lord Siva over the demons Tripuri. Lord Siva danced Tāndava, his dance of destruction. This year we are observing the victory of Lord Siva during Pradosham day Rudrābhishekam, which falls on the 13th day (Trayodashi) of the lunar fortnight (Paksha), followed by Jyotirlingārchana.

Join us with family and friends and take part in Pradosham Siva abhishekam, followed by Jyotirlinga Dēpārādhane, Archana, and Arathi and obtain the blessings of Lord Siva.
