Significance of Deepavali/Diwali

Diwali is one of the most important festivals of the year. Diwali involves the lighting of small clay lamps (*dīpa* in Sanskrit: दीप) filled with oil to signify the triumph of good over evil. These lamps are kept on during the night and one's house is cleaned, both done in order to make the Goddess Lakshmi feel welcome. Diwāli is the day Lord Vishnu came back to Goddess Lakshmi and their abode in the Vaikuntha.

Those who worship Goddess Lakshmi receive the benefit of her good mood, and therefore are blessed with mental, physical and material well-being during the year ahead.

During Diwāli, all the celebrants wear new clothes and share sweets and snacks with family members and friends. Join us with your family and friends during this year's festival of lights events, added with fireworks display in the evening.
