Karwa Chauth is celebrated mostly amongst our North Indian community, settled either in US or in other parts of the world as well. As the name signifies, Karwa meaning a clay pot and chauth corresponding to the fourth, this festival is commemorated on the fourth day after the Full Moon in Kartik month of Hindu calendar.

Karwa Chauth is celebrated during midst-harvesting of summer crops. Apart from fasting, married woman pray for the long life of their husbands; people like to remember and meet their relatives and friends, and exchange gifts with them. Thus, Karwa Chauth is very much a social and seasonal festival.
