DURGA MATA JAGRAN

Jāgran (जागरण) or Jāgrata (जागरता) or Jāga is a Hindu ritual, consisting of all-night vigil, songs and dance in honor of Durga Mata. It is believed that the mother visits in form of a jot (flame) which is lit before the ceremony.

It is mostly popular in Northern part of India. The Process of Jagran starts with lighting the lamp called "Jyoti Prajwalan" followed by devotional songs, offerings to Mata Durga, reciting the story of Tara Rani, and ends with the morning Aarti around 4:00 AM. The whole purpose of the Jagran is spiritual awakening for attainment of link up with Supreme Power.

Normally Jagran is performed by a lead singer accompanied by group of musicians and chorus. It is a spectacular event with full of energy and devotion. Join us and take part in the Jagran event which starts from 9:00 pm onwards and obtain Durga Mata's blessings.
