Sri Satyanarayana Puja

The puja itself is from the Skanda Purana. Sutha Puranik-ji, a Rishi, narrates the story to a group of Rishis who were performing a 1,000 year yagya for the general benefit of mankind. They went to Sutha Puranik-ji, and asked him how an individual having an ethical, life affirming desire, could have that desire fulfilled. Suta Maha Muni tells the Rishis that this Puja is especially effective during the time of Kali Yuga.

One who reads the story and one who hears it will be rid of all woes and difficulties. Pray with faith and devotion that Lord Satyanarayana may remove all the obstacles that you experience on the spiritual path. Join us during this vishesh event with your family and obtain Lord's blessings.

Puja Items

Significance of Holika Dahan

Holi (Sanskrit: होली) is a symbolic commemoration of a legend from Hindu Mythology. The festival's preamble begins on the night of the full moon during the month of March. Bonfires are lit to cleanse the air of evil spirits and bad vibes, and to symbolize the destruction of the wicked Holika, for whom the festival was named and to signify the death of Holika in order to save Prahlad.
