Navagrahas

In Sanskrit, nava means nine and graha means seizing, laying hold of, or holding. According to Vedic scriptures our ancestral saints and sages found that there were certain forces which influenced or impacted the life of a human-being greatly. They recognized the nine powerful ones and termed them as Navagrahas.

They are: Surya (Sun), Chandra (Moon), Mangala (Mars), Budha (Mercury), Brihaspati/Guru (Jupiter), Shukra (Venus), Shani (Saturn), Rahu (North Lunar Node) and Ketu (South Lunar Node).

The Navagrahas are worshipped as celestial deities since ages in temples.
