Significance of Aadi Krithigai Celebrations

Ādi Krithigai is an important festival celebrated in the Tamil month of Ādi. The festival is dedicated to Lord Muruga or Subrahmanya. The Krithigai star or Nakshatram is considered highly auspicious to worship Muruga and Ādi krithigai is more important because Aadi is the first month in the Dakshinayana Punyakalam – when the Sun God changes his direction from north to south.

The festival is celebrated very grand with various rituals (pūja, Abhishekam, and Kāvadi) at all murugan temples around the world. This year at HTCC, community members are celebrating the event in a grand manner on Sunday 23rd. Join us with family and friends in the rituals and get the blessings of Lord Muruga.

Note: According to Hindu Lunar calendar (NW Pacific Time zone), Ādi Krithigai is performed on July 18th, Tuesday. Abhishekam is performed in the evening as well. Refer on line schedules for details.
