DURGA MĀTA JĀGRAN

Jāgran (जागरण) or Jāgrata (जागरता) or Jāga is a Hindu ritual, consisting of all-night vigil, songs and dance in honor of Durga Māta. It is believed that the mother visits in form of a jot (flame) which is lit before the ceremony.

It is mostly popular in Northern part of India. The Process of Jāgran starts with lighting the lamp called "Jyoti Prajwalan" followed by devotional songs, offerings to Māta Durga, reciting the story of Tāra Rāni, and ends with the early morning Āarti around 6:00 AM. The whole purpose of the Jāgran is spiritual awakening for attainment of link up with Supreme Power.

Normally Jāgran is performed by a lead singer accompanied by group of musicians and chorus. It is a spectacular event with full of energy and devotion. Join us and take part in the Jāgran event which starts from 9:00 pm onwards and obtain Durga Māta's blessings.
