* If 121 chanters chant 11 times each, simultaneously we get 1331 cumulative count

Hinduism is referred to in Sanskrit as Sanāthana Dharma (i.e. Perennial religion). The Vedas - the crest jewel among the world scriptures, form the bedrock of Sanāthana Dharma. The Hindus believe the Vedas to be apaurusheyam – i.e. not of human origin, and in fact accept them as the very breath of the Eternal (sarvAni nihshvasitAni). At the core of these Holy Vedas is the famous hymn Sri Rudram, where the Infinite Eternal Changeless Reality is adored with devotional fervor as Lord Siva.

In the Vedic tradition, this hymn – Sri Rudram is akin to the face of Lord Siva and the universal mantra “Namassivāya” (translation: Salutations to Lord Siva) which is enshrined at the center of this hymn is symbolic of the third eye of knowledge, adorning the Lord’s forehead. Chanting Sri Rudram leads to the attainment of DHARMA (meaningful life), ARTHA (right means – wealth, health, education etc.), KĀMA (Righteous desires) AND MOKSHA (freedom from suffering).

Sri Mahārudram is community-level group chanting and worship effort, wherein Sri Rudram is chanted 1331 times (cumulatively) by several well trained chanters (Ritwiks) with the singular goal of praying for world welfare and harmony. This event culminates in a Maha Homam (fire sacrifice) which is symbolic of offering our heart, mind and soul in a deep spirit of devotion, to Lord Siva (symbolized by fire). The word Yajna itself implies cooperative endeavor. So come, let’s all participate in making this Sri Mahārudra Yajna, a grand success! For schedules and sponsorship details, please turn over.
