Śri Satyanārāyana Puja: The puja itself is from the Skanda Purana. Sutha Puranik-ji, a Rishi, narrates the story to a group of Rishis, for the general benefit of mankind. They went to Sutha Puranik-ji, and asked him how an individual having an ethical, life affirming desire, could have that desire fulfilled. Suta Maha Muni tells the Rishis that this Puja is especially effective during the time of Kali Yuga. One who reads the story and one who hears it will be rid of all woes and difficulties.

Significance of Hanumān Jayanti: Hanuman Jayanti is celebrated every year with great devotion and faith. It is celebrated across the globe to commemorate the birth day of Sri Hanumān. The celebrations at HTCC takes place on the Chaitra Purnima day, when Sri Hanumān is believed to have taken birth.
