Bālālayam Prathiṣṭha, August 14th – 16th 2026



Om Namo Venkatēsāya!!

Bālālayam is a process of creating a temporary temple structure during the renovation time until Mahā Kumbhābhishekam ceremony which takes place once in every 12 years in Hindu Temple. The divine energy (Prana Shakthi) of Moola Mūrthis in Garbha Gruhas is transferred to holy waters contained in Kalashams by priests with Vedic rituals, manthras, hōmam etc. and place these Kalashams in Bālālayam. 'Bāla' means mini and 'Ālaya' means temple in Sanskrit. According to Vaikhānasa Āgama Shāstra proceedings, a temple cannot be left completely without divine energy, the Bālālayam serves as a miniature temple where Nithya Poojas and other rituals is done to these Kalashams and Utsava Mūrthis until Mahā Kumbhābhishekam. During the Jeernodharana (renovation period) of a temple, the devotees will not be able to take darshan or do archana to the Moola Mūrthis. The scheduled poojas will be done only to Utsava Mūrthis and Kalashams in Bālālayam. The divine presence of Moola Mūrthis will be in Kalashams in Bālālayam until Prāna Shakthi is transferred back to Bimbam (Moola Mūrthis) during Mahā Kumbhābhishekam in September and Nithya Pooja and other scheduled Poojas to Moola Mūrthis will start only after Mahā Kumbhābhishekam.
