Jāgran (जागरण) or Jāgrata (जागरता) or Jāga is a Hindu ritual, consisting of all-night vigil, songs and dance in honor of Durga Māta. It is believed that the mother visits in form of a jot (flame) which is lit before the ceremony. The Process of Jāgran starts with lighting the lamp called "Jyoti Prajwalan" followed by devotional songs ends with the early morning Ārti.
